

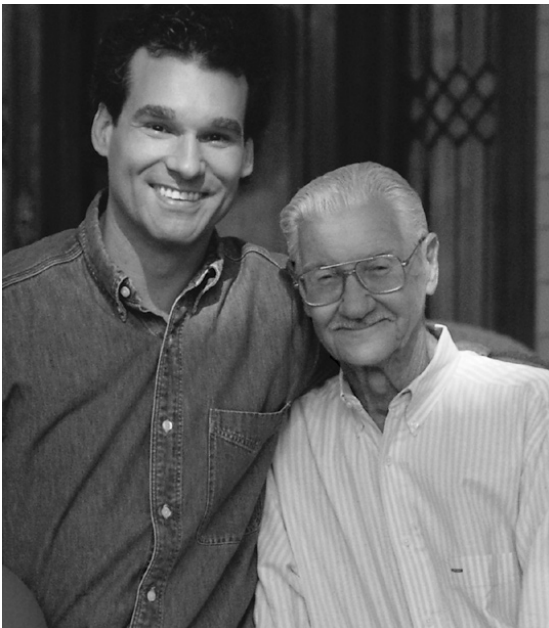

A free community program



Do your loved ones know the health care you wish to receive if you become incapacitated after a serious accident or illness? Do not burden them with guessing your wishes. Attend a free community program on how to control your health care and ensure that your choices are honored.

Less than 25% of Americans have voiced or documented their wishes for health care at the end of life. Dr. Bruce Richards gives clear and simple explanations on how advance directives, medical durable power of attorney, and living wills ensure your wishes are respected.

Participants use a worksheet to complete the Five Wishes, a legal document that is instrumental in providing family members and health care providers information about choices regarding end-of-life care.
