On Sept. 16 and 17, a CDC-sponsored research team will hold a focus group to learn more about the experience of using QuantiFERON®-TB Gold in Tube (QFT GIT) blood tests for screening health care workers for latent tuberculosis infection.

Associates are invited to attend this group because PSF associates received the QFT GIT as part of the regular health examination as a health care associate.

Goal: To generate national educational curriculum based on associate insights.

Task: As a participant, associates will meet in a focus group with six to eight additional associates to discuss their QFT GIT screening experience. (Don't worry if you don't remember receiving the screening test.)
